The ToronCare line covers manual and electric homecare hospital beds built to IEC 60601-2-52, from simple fixed-height frames to fully automated nursing beds. Each model suits a different level of care, mobility, and budget.

Families, nursing homes, and long-term care facilities use these beds to lower caregiver strain, prevent pressure ulcers, and keep patients comfortable for long periods. This range spans manual cranks, push-button electric controls, hi-low height adjustment, lateral turning, and built-in toileting, so you can match the bed to the patient and the setting.

Applications

Homecare hospital beds support extended care wherever a patient spends long periods in bed, at home or in a facility.

- Home-Based Long-Term Care: gives families a safe, adjustable bed for relatives with chronic illness or limited mobility.
- Post-Surgical and Rehabilitation Recovery: backrest and leg positioning help patients rest, sit up, and recover after surgery or injury.
- Elderly and Dementia Care: low heights, fall-prevention rails, and stable bases protect aging and at-risk patients.
- Stroke and Neurological Recovery: turning and tilt functions reposition patients who cannot move themselves.
- Palliative and Hospice Care: gentle positioning and in-bed hygiene keep patients comfortable and dignified.
- Nursing Homes and Long-Term Care Facilities: durable frames and simple controls support continuous, multi-shift use.

Homecare Hospital Bed Range

Model	Type & Operation	Description
ToronCare™ 1080	Electric, stationary (no castors)	Stationary bed on a four-piece stand-board base instead of castors, with remote backrest, leg-rest, and hi-low height. The non-rolling design suits fall-risk and cognitively impaired patients who need a stable, stay-put bed.
ToronCare™ 5081	Manual, multifunction	Hand-cranked bed that needs no electricity, with lateral turning, a chair position, a built-in toilet opening, and a bed-side shampoo station. A budget choice for off-grid homes and cost-conscious long-term care.
ToronCare™ 5083	Electric, multifunction	Push-button bed with electric lateral turning, a one-key chair position, electric toileting, a one-button CPR flat, and a back-up battery for outages. Suits caregiver-intensive and emergency-ready home care.
ToronCare™ 1085	Electric, foldable hi-low	Cost-effective folding bed that one person can assemble without tools, with hi-low height (335 to 725 mm), backrest, knee bend, and Trendelenburg tilt. Easy to ship, store, and move between rooms.
ToronCare™ 5086	Electric, hi-low adjustable	Heavy-duty bed with a wide 240 to 640 mm height range, whole-bed Trendelenburg tilt, and a 240 kg capacity. The ultra-low height protects fall-risk patients, and an optional stand-assist rail aids transfers.
ToronCare™ 5088	Electric, premium automated	Flagship bed with automated timed turning, voice-guided controls, an anti-slide chair, a powered commode pan, and an emergency stop. Built for high-dependency and around-the-clock care.
ToronCare™ 1090	Electric, fixed-height	The simplest and lightest model at 80 kg, with a fixed 380 mm height and remote backrest (to 75°) and leg-rest control. A straightforward, low-maintenance choice for general and outpatient care.
