Cryostat

A Cryostat is a low-temperature sectioning system used to prepare thin frozen tissue sections for pathology, histology, clinical diagnosis, and laboratory research. In a typical Cryostat Microtome workflow, the specimen, blade area, and working zone are kept at controlled low temperatures so tissue can be cut cleanly without softening during sectioning. This makes a Cryostat Machine especially useful for fast frozen-section work, where speed and temperature stability directly affect section quality.

ToronCryo™ Series is developed to support frozen section preparation across different laboratory needs, from compact freezing accessories for compatible microtomes to fully integrated floor-standing cryostat systems. Across the brochure lineup, the CR Series is positioned for hospitals, pathology labs, research institutions, and other environments that need reliable low-temperature tissue preparation, stable cooling control, and practical daily operation.

2. Fully Automatic Cryostat - ToronCryo™ 400

It features intelligent temperature control, semi-automatic sectioning, touchscreen operation, multi-point refrigeration, and rapid freezing for up to 12 specimens. 3. Dual Compressor Cryostat - ToronCryo™ 500
