- Compact benchtop footprint: with a listed size of 400 × 350 × 350 mm and net weight of 30.5 kg, the unit is compact enough for routine laboratory bench installation while still offering a stable mechanical layout.

THEORY & METHOD

Theory and Method

A Rotary Microtome produces thin sections by advancing a specimen block toward a blade in controlled increments. The operator mounts the sample, aligns it relative to the blade, sets the desired thickness, and rotates the handwheel to generate sections for microscopy or related analytical work. This method is the core operating principle of manual and semi-mechanical rotary sectioning systems. Stable Rotary Microtome - ToronTome™ 350 is a rotary microtome designed for precision sectioning.

ToronTome™ 350 uses a precision roller cross guide and a rigid mechanical structure to support smoother specimen travel and stable cutting. The blade carrier can be adjusted and the handwheel can be locked in any position, which helps the operator control blade geometry and specimen handling during trimming and sectioning.

Section quality depends on feed stability, specimen alignment, blade sharpness, and vibration control. That is why this Microtome focuses on a strong alloy-steel structure, guided specimen movement, and a compact sectioning layout intended for dependable daily performance.
